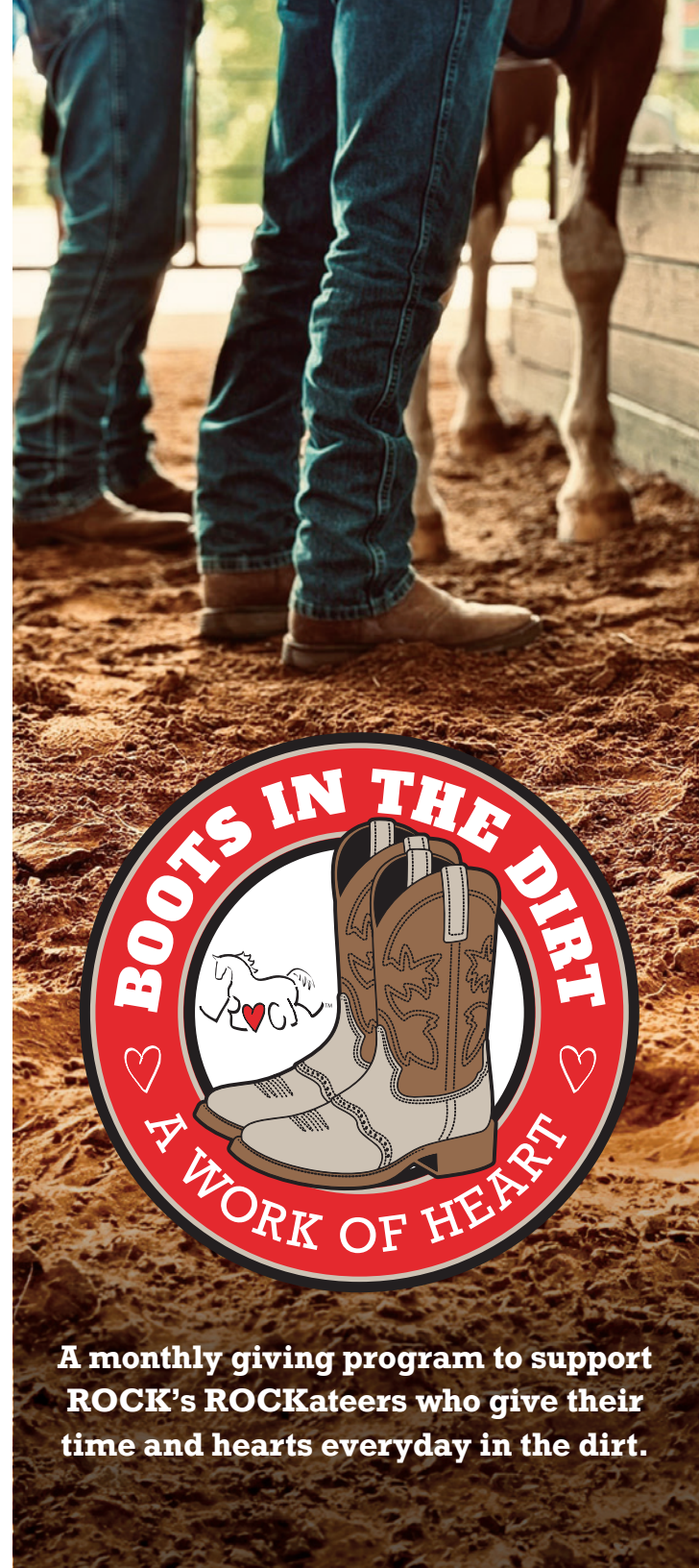

is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization that provides equine-assisted services to children, adults, and veterans with physical and cognitive challenges. ROCK is located on 60+ beautiful acres in Georgetown, Texas. Serving Central Texas since 1998, ROCK's mission is to improve independence and life skills in partnership with the horse. ROCK is a PATH Intl. (Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship International) Premier Accredited Center.



ROCK programs include:

Speech & Physical Therapy Incorporating Equine Movement

Physical and speech therapy which incorporates equine movement as part of a therapeutic plan.

Adaptive Riding

Increasing functional life skills in individuals with special needs by allowing them to experience the benefits of horseback riding in an encouraging environment.

ROCK On Veterans

Veterans and active military are partnered with ROCK horses and veteran ROCKateers, building a supportive community and a healing environment.

Summer Camps

ROCK offers summer camps full of fun and learning about the horse during the summer months that includes Camp Bright Side, an inclusion camp, and Camp Courage which is offered to children of veterans and active-duty service members.

Sponsor Giving Levels

ROCK's Boots in the Dirt Club allows those who can't volunteer in person to support our ROCKateer Department by funding training, materials, and personnel. Your monthly credit card gift provides reliable support, enabling our ROCKateers to continue their amazing work with the proper training, tools, and gratitude.

According to the Independent Sector and the Do Good Institute, as of April 2024, the national value of a volunteer hour is estimated at \$33.49, a 5.3% increase from 2022. These volunteers' roles are vital to our program's success. Without them, ROCK would be unable to bear the cost of employing ENOUGH staff to carry out all of the lessons.

\$10 Equine Assistance Team

Dedicated ROCKateers work on a regular basis mucking stalls, washing troughs, cleaning the feed room, and other tasks to ensure a clean and healthy living environment for our horses.

\$25 Participant Support Team

Horse Handlers and Side Walkers undergo extensive training to learn how to support our participants in a safe manner. These ROCKateers attend training classes from 5 to 20 hours to become qualified to work with our horses, providing support to our participants.

\$50 Equine Support Team

Our horses love to be loved and love to look their best. Our Equine Support Team provides grooming and bathing so they can maintain a clean and neat appearance. These ROCKateers also spend time providing love and general exercise for our horses.

\$100 Facilities Support Team

Our dedicated ROCKateers maintain our sixty acres for the safety of our horses, staff, and ROCKateers. They repair fences, paint buildings, and handle minor facility repairs.
